NOTE: New York State and the Federal Government have not yet released the amount of summer funds available to hire youth this summer. One thing is for certain: there will be far less than last year which means fewer youth will be hired. Young people should also be encouraged to seek volunteer work in their community to help gain experience for future work.

- 1. ACT NOW!** Encourage youth to contact the appropriate staff person directly by calling the phone numbers provided. Before referring a youth, you may find it useful to speak in advance with the agency offering summer jobs about the specific needs of the young person.
- 2. YOU CAN APPLY TO ONE PROGRAM –STAFF WILL ENSURE THAT YOUR APPLICATION GETS TO THE RIGHT PLACE FOR YOU.**
- 3. FOLLOW UP** to be sure that information has been received and is being processed.

Note to users: Program information is provided based on the municipality in which you or the young person you know lives. Also note that some programs serve youth from throughout Tompkins County.

*****WORK PERMIT***** If you are between the ages of 14-17 you need to get a work permit before you can start working. The medical office handles this for most schools-check in with yours to get your permit now before summer!
